PRI Wellness Corps

PRI Wellness Corps is a partnership between Pamlico Rose Institute and AmeriCorps dedicated to advancing well-being through inclusive programming in community wellness gardens. These gardens meet people where they are—providing safe, welcoming spaces that promote healthy living, connection, healing, and growth. The PRI Wellness Corps supports garden sites across North Carolina, including its flagship wellness gardens in Aurora.

Member Impact

Members have the opportunity to reach underserved and at-risk community members, promoting wellness through their service. Service focuses on mitigating food insecurity, fostering community connections, and providing opportunities to learn about and develop skills supporting healthy living.

Essential Functions of Position

- Seasonally aligned garden activities may include garden construction, preparation, planting, garden maintenance and harvesting, bed preparation, weeding, mulching, watering, pruning, and general garden cleanup.
- Members may teach and/or guide and work with community groups and individual community members to advance wellness events and activities:
- Promote Briggs volunteer opportunities and workdays during pantry distribution and other campus events.
- Oversee volunteer activities at Briggs Garden and Cooperative Extension Office.
- Assist with community events at Cooperative Extension as assigned including tabling to promote programs, helping educators during cooking classes
- Assist beekeepers in Durham County Beekeeping Association to maintain beehives.

Eligibility Requirements

- At least 18 years old and a US Citizen
- Access to reliable transportation
- Pass background check (National Sex Offender Registry, State of Residence and FBI Fingerprint Checks)
- Preferred High School or GED Diploma

Briggs Avenue Community Garden is a 45acre forested lot located in East Durham, on S Briggs Avenue between E Lawson St. and Riddle Rd., across from East Coast Metal Distributors. Its purpose is to provide an urban garden for Durham families to affordably grow healthy food, learn about sustainable agriculture, conserve pollinators, build community, and increase food security. The Garden engages citizens of all ages providing free hands-on agriculture education, recreation, and fellowship in a low-stress, supportive environment. We seek to empower citizens with access to agriculture information and production. It is open to the public but seeks to attract resource-limited groups. The Garden was dedicated in 2010 as an agricultural education space.

Commitment Required

- Three-Quarter Time (TQT) AmeriCorps Member Service Year, with 1200 hours of service expected over the service term (approximately 30 hours per week)
- Permits working at another job or attending school during non-service hours
- ·AmeriCorps gear provided and some gear must be worn during all service hours

Member Benefits

- Living Allowance: \$625 bi-monthly, not to exceed \$15,000 for the service year. Mental Health First Aid Training

- Other Professional Development Training Education Award (\$3697.50 for the half-time member role), which may be transferred to another person (e.g. child, grandchild) if the member 55 yrs of age or older
- May be eligible for loan deferment during the service
- On completion of the service year, gain access to the AmeriCorps Alums national network (1+ million members); qualify for Non-competitive eligibility for federal employment; and receive consideration for employment by National Service agencies

EEOC
