



# The Pamlico Rose Institute Artist in Residence Program

The Artist-in-Residence is a 6-month program for aspiring artists who are women Veterans, active military or current/former health care workers who worked primarily with Veterans. The program will provide a supportive, creative and enriching virtual and onsite environment for artists to work outside of their artistic framework providing time to reflect, research or produce work while exploring new themes or materials/media. The residency will contribute funding and resources to the artist during the artist's tenure.

The artist in residency program is part of Pamlico Rose Institute's mission to advance wellness and resiliency-building programs, activities and experiences to women Veterans and for the residency, including women who are active military and health care workers supporting Veterans. The residency program, like much of the wellness efforts offered by Pamlico Rose sits at the intersection of nature, creative expression, and transcendence.

## Pamlico Rose Artists:



will produce at least ten pieces of art during the residency  
will create one work to be provided to Pamlico Rose that will permanently be displayed in the gardens or other areas of the Center



will give one (1) public presentation on her work in the 5th month of the residency. The presentation will be open to the public and will either be given at the Center (also live streamed) or on Zoom  
will provide periodic updates on work to be posted on Pamlico Rose social media outlets.



will provide artwork for a culminating exhibit at the conclusion of the residency. The work will be on display for two weeks after the opening day of the exhibit  
will be encouraged to offer most or all of their work in that exhibit for sale with all proceeds from sales going to the artist

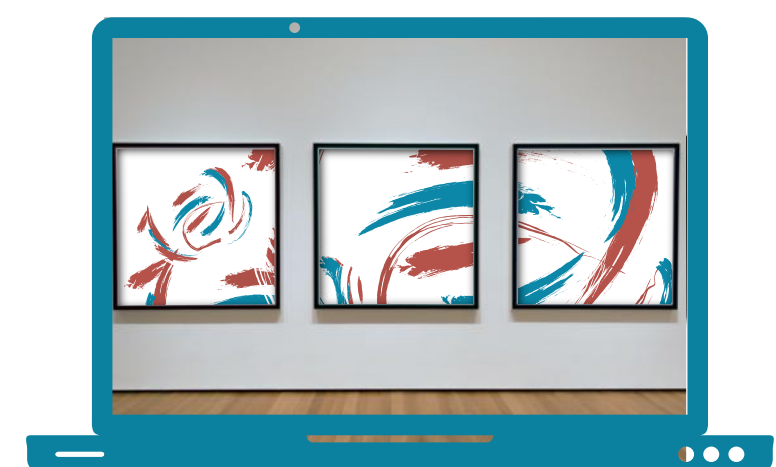
## The Pamlico Rose Institute:
